- Manage the technical aspects of project maturation and delivery including customer partnering.

- Drive activities related to licensing and data access.

Requirements include

- Bachelor's or Master's degree in engineering, geoscience or other related subject.
- Technical background with significant hands-on experience within business development, technical screening, concept selection (subsurface, drilling and surface), permitting, appraisal, project execution and operations.
- Strong organizational and analytical skills with the ability to manage multiple projects simultaneously.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- To succeed in this role, it is important that you are solution oriented, proactive and have the ability to drive project teams to successful outcomes.
- Fluency in English along with either German or Polish.
