Responsibilities

- Draft subcontracts, NDAs, and other project-related agreements to ensure they meet legal and organizational standards
- Collaborate with stakeholders in the organization to review and evaluate the contractual and commercial risks associated with contracts and assist departments in determining which risks are acceptable and which are not, using a balanced approach of steadfastness and pragmatism tailored to the specific situation.

- Work closely with internal stakeholders to ensure a thorough understanding of contractual obligations and risks.
- Conduct post-process follow-ups and evaluations to review processes, negotiations, and contracts, aiming to enhance internal procedures and set better prerequisites for future projects.
